



Job Description: Adult Sailing Instructor - Dinghies

Place of Employment: Olympia Community Sailing (Olympia, WA)

Employment Dates: June 17, 2024 - August 30, 2024 (flexible, possibility for work on either end of time frame)

Compensation: Hourly wages are approximately \$18.00 an hour or higher, depending on experience and seniority.

Job Description:

Instructors independently teach Adult Sailing classes using dinghies. They are ultimately responsible for the class. They will lead chalk-talks, monitor progress of students' learning, assess sailing conditions, and be in charge of time management. Instructors defer to Directors and Coaches. Instructors may be operating out of the Olympia Yacht Club or Swantown Marina locations.

Requirements

- US Sailing Level 1 Certified, or greater
- Current First Aid/CPR, Boaters Card, and Safesport Certifications
- Previous experience teaching Adults or Teens on dinghies
- Transportation (ability to travel between OYC and Swantown Marina locations before and after class to pick up and return supplies)

Specific Responsibilities

- Wear staff uniform
- Report any incidents to the Director immediately (safety issues, staff issues, OYC member issues, etc.)
- Lead assigned class independently
- Adhere to OCS curriculum plan
- Design and implement lesson plans, chalk talks, and drills
- Responsible for appointed class and Junior Instructors
- Time management
- Boat and equipment maintenance
- Checking in at Olympia Yacht Club location before class to obtain class supplies and after class ends to return supplies/equipment
- Ensuring equipment is properly put away at end of class
- Overseeing safety, discipline and energy of students
- Driving powerboats safely
